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## Covid-19 Status: Per the Governor's Proclamation

### REOPENING OF BUSINESSES AND ESTABLISHMENTS

**SECTION TWO.** Pursuant to Iowa Code § 135.144 (3), and in conjunction with the Iowa Department of Public Health, unless otherwise modified by subsequent proclamation or order of the Iowa Department of Public Health, I hereby order that effective at 12:01 a.m. on May 28, 2020 and until 11:59 p.m. on June 17, 2020:

**A. Restaurants and bars:** A restaurant or bar, including a wedding reception venue, winery, brewery, distillery, **country club**, or other social or fraternal club, may reopen or remain open to serve food and beverages on its premises, but only to the extent that it complies with the following requirements:

- (1) Capacity limited:** The establishment must limit the number of customers present at indoor or outdoor spaces to 50% of its normal operating seating capacity to ensure adequate spacing of groups. An establishment that ordinarily has a larger operating capacity for patrons standing is not prohibited from adding additional tables and chairs, provided that doing so complies with all other provisions of this Proclamation and any other applicable law.
- (2) Groups limited:** The establishment must limit party size seated together to no more than ten people.
- (3) Social distancing:** The establishment must ensure at least six feet of physical distance between each group or individual dining or drinking alone. Seating at booths closer than six feet may satisfy this requirement if the booths are separated by a barrier of a sufficient height to fully separate seated customers. All patrons must have a seat at a table or bar, and an establishment must limit patrons from congregating together closer than six feet.
- (4) Self-service prohibited:** The establishment must not have any self-service of food, including buffets or salad bars.
- (5) Live performances:** An establishment may have live music performances, provided that any performer remains at least six feet away from patrons and other performers, and the establishment does not permit patrons from congregating together closer than six feet.
- (6) Other social distancing, hygiene, and public health measures:** The restaurant shall also implement reasonable measures under the circumstances of each restaurant to ensure social distancing of employees and customers, increased hygiene practices, and other public health measures to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19 consistent with guidance issued by the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals and the Iowa Department of Public Health.

We are cleaning the restrooms more frequently so please be patient if a staff member isn't at the window right away. Disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer is available at both the walkup window and on the bar. Coolers are wiped down with disinfectant after they are returned to the clubhouse before the next person.

Mitch Haugen made a 100 square board at \$10 per square 50/50 raffle. The entire board sold in ONE tournament. Jimmy Mitchell won \$500 and donated back \$50. The club's half (\$500) was deposited into our savings account at Bank Iowa.

## 2020 Stag Night and Tournament Committees

The clubhouse committee met and discussed the stag and tournament needs. Because of Covid-19 at this time and into the foreseeable future we cannot offer self-serve (plate up your own food). Gloves have to be worn when working with food. The serving calendar is on the website along with member contact information. If you don't know how to get ahold of someone, look there. - **Men's Stag Committees**

1. There are fewer members on the committees because you will NOT have to stay and serve until the last group comes in.
2. Please bring your food **PREPARED** (hot, ready to go) to the clubhouse NO later than 5pm. Potato, Vegetable, Salad and Dessert. Serving starts at 5:30pm.
3. After you have dropped off your food you may golf, play cards, whatever. Your containers, crock pots, pans, etc. should be labeled with your name. We will have everything cleaned up at the end of the evening. We do have crock pots and roaster at the clubhouse that you are more than welcome to get ahead of time.
4. The cost of the meal is \$7.50. The increase is to help offset the cost of having a staff member serving, cleaning, etc.
5. Sign-up: You are sent a text message on Sundays reminding you to sign up. You can reply to that text message, send an email to [plumcreekgolfing@gmail.com](mailto:plumcreekgolfing@gmail.com), leave a message at 563.237.6401 or text Ranae. We will be cooking for the number signed up. Should you come in on Tuesday and decide to eat there may not be enough. This is why we have a signup process so people can plan. It's different if you had plans but they changed at the last minute; just ask to see if there is enough.

- **Ladies Stag Committees**

1. There are fewer members on the committees because you will NOT have to stay and serve, hopefully the ladies that come out at 5pm a chance to golf and then eat when they are done. No one will be packing up and leaving after they serve at 6pm unless none of the golfers are signed up to eat.
2. Please bring your food **PREPARED** (hot, ready to go) to the clubhouse NO later than 5:45pm. Main Dish, Salad and Dessert.
3. After you have dropped off your food you may golf, play cards, whatever. Your containers, crock pots, pans, etc. should be labeled with your name. We will have everything cleaned up at the end of the evening. We do have crock pots and roaster at the clubhouse that you are more than welcome to get ahead of time.

4. Sign-up: You are sent a text message on Tuesday's reminding you to sign up. You can reply to that text message, send an email to [plumcreekgolfing@gmail.com](mailto:plumcreekgolfing@gmail.com), leave a message at 563.237.6401 or text Ranae. We will be cooking for the number signed up. Should you come in on Thursday and decide to eat there may not be enough. This is why we have a signup process so people can plan. It's different if you had plans but they changed at the last minute; just ask to see if there is enough.
5. The cost of your meal will stay the same as of now \$7.50.

- **Tournament Committees:**

- You shall arrive at 10:30am. You will have to grill burgers/brat patties, serve baked beans and chips. Bars will need to be brought to the clubhouse **ALREADY cut and in baggies**. You will also have to clean up.
  - ~ The Silver Bullet will have a first shift from 10am to 2pm and second shift 2pm to 6pm.
- Bars – one pan per person. If a couple is serving that means two pans of 9x13. If a single person is serving that means one pan 9x13. If it is a larger tournament Ranae will contact the committee about bringing additional bars.
- Everything is setup for you in the kitchen when you get there. You do not take money. Each golfer has a ticket for lunch so that we know how many are left to serve.
- We start serving lunch at 11:30am and serve until the last team comes in to eat. That could be 2pm, 3pm, 4pm depends on when the teams want to eat.

Should you NOT be able to serve you can #1. work it out with your committee, #2. pay the \$50 opt out fee per person or #3 find a replacement/switch with someone else. For tournaments you should only be serving every other year or two. If you were on a committee last year and the tournament was canceled you are probably signed up for this year. If you skip your committee duties you will be sent a bill for \$50.

Jo Ellen moved to accept the minutes from March - make note there was no April meeting due to Covid-19, seconded by Trevor. All in favor.
